

1. **Character** - A person or animal who takes role in the story of a literary work.
2. **Conflict** - A struggle between forces being against.

-**Internal** - A character that struggles within the mind.

-**External** - A character that struggles within the outside force.

3. **Foreshadowing** - Clues that suggest events that have signals in a story.
4. **Mood** - The feeling created from the reader by a story or passage.
5. **Protagonist** - The main character in a literary story.
6. **Antagonist** - A character forced in conflict with the main character.
7. **Setting** - A story of the time and place.
8. **Symbol** - Anything that represents something.
9. **Theme** - The main message, concern, or purpose in a story.
